***CABINET MEMBERS AND DELEGATE JOIN ROUNDTABLE TO DISCUSS
CONNECTIVITY AND BROADBAND ACCESS IN SCHOOLS***

HARRISONBURG, VA – Secretary of Education Anne Holton and Secretary of Technology Karen Jackson will visit Harrisonburg High School on Tuesday, April 7 at 12:00 PM to experience digital learning in the classroom and later join a roundtable to discuss issues related to school connectivity. Superintendent of Schools Dr. Scott Kizner looks forward to sharing with the Secretaries how HCPS uses technology to transform and enhance learning.

Roundtable participants will include Delegate Tony Wilt, members of a newly formed consortium of school technology directors and EducationSuperHighway representatives. Fifteen public school districts formed the consortium last month to coordinate technology planning to ensure that each member has sufficient broadband to support digital learning in schools in the next 2-5 years.

The demand for bandwidth is expected to increase tenfold in the next five years, according to leading school connectivity experts.

AccelerateK-12 aims to identify all high-impact strategies that will improve K-12 connectivity and ensure all Virginian students have sufficient broadband Internet for digital learning.
